CAB1 Minutes

Minutes of the meeting held on 5 May 2022 as published on 6 May 2022 were agreed as a correct record.

CAB2 Staffordshire Sustainability Board - Vision and Base Pledge 2022

Considered a report presenting the Staffordshire Sustainability Board Vision and Base Pledge 2022.

The Cabinet Member, Climate Change Portfolio reaffirmed the Councils commitment to tackling climate change, as demonstrated by the establishing of a new Cabinet Portfolio to raise this important issue across all service areas of the Council.

Councillor Price introduced the report and highlighted the detail contained within Paragraphs 3 and 5 before noting that the reason the Council had such a robust approach to climate change was attributed to the efforts of Officers this area of work. The Cabinet Member also noted the Councils input to the Staffordshire Joint Waste Management Board whose aims were closely linked to the matter at hand.

Councillor Price concluded his comments by recommending that said proposal be approved.

The Cabinet subsequently voted on the recommendation, which was declared to be carried.

CAB3 Street Naming and Numbering Policy and Procedure

The Cabinet Member, Economic Development and Planning Portfolio highlighted Paragraph 5.3 of the report and concluded her comments by recommending that the proposal as detailed in Paragraph 2 be approved.

The Cabinet voted on the recommendation, which was declared to be carried.
